Referral

Process

- ◇ A child may be referred to FDDC by a Physician, family member, or a child caregiver.
- ◇ Upon a referral for testing, a prescription/EPST form will be required from your physician for testing.
- ◇ A testing appointment will be scheduled and a licensed examiner will conduct an age appropriate developmental evaluation using both standardized and curriculum based tests.
- ◇ If a child meets the qualification criteria based on the test result, FDDC service coordinators will meet with parents and develop a plan for services.
- ◇ Parents will take copies of the evaluation and proposed individual program plan for the physician's approval.
- ◇ After reviewing and approving these documents, the physician will complete a physical evaluation form and 640 addendum indicating approval of the service.

Who We Serve

Children in our Day Habilitation Program must go through a referral and testing process to determine if they meet the criteria for services, which include developmental delays in two or more areas including:

- ◇ Motor Skills
- ◇ Cognitive Skills
- ◇ Language Skills
- ◇ Self-help Skills
- ◇ Social Skills

* Children who qualify may also be referred and tested for speech, occupational, and physical therapies.
